Last fall's Walk-a-Thon was a great success – Mount Hope families raised over \$21,000 for scholarships and had lots of fun at the same time! Please join us this year on Saturday, November 5th. The Walk-a-Thon is a wonderful event for the *whole* family.

As mentioned in Parent Orientation, this year's proceeds will not be designated to one single project; rather they will be used to target areas we would like to enhance at Mount Hope. The main areas of focus include: (1) obtaining more building space (the growth trend of enrollment shows an impending need for more classroom space) – the ultimate goal is to acquire enough additional space to house a library, computer lab and a gymnasium; and (2) raising staff salaries (we would like salaries to better reflect the market and the high quality of care our children are provided every day at Mount Hope).

Your child can obtain sponsors in two ways – through Level Sponsorships and Pledge Sponsors.

Level Sponsorship – The attached Sponsor Registration Form outlines how you, your family business, or someone you know can support our event. (Please note the deadlines for each level of sponsorship.)

Pledge Sponsors – Color-coded weekly Sponsor Pledge Forms and instructions are also attached. Please help your child obtain as many pledges as possible. Raising \$200 is as simple as 8 people giving \$25 to your child (or 4 people giving \$50 to your child!).

Prizes will be awarded for the most money raised in each class, as well as three grand prizes for the most money raised in the whole school! *All* participants will receive an official Walk-a-Thon t-shirt.
